Improve Math proficiency rates for English Learner students from 40% to 55%.

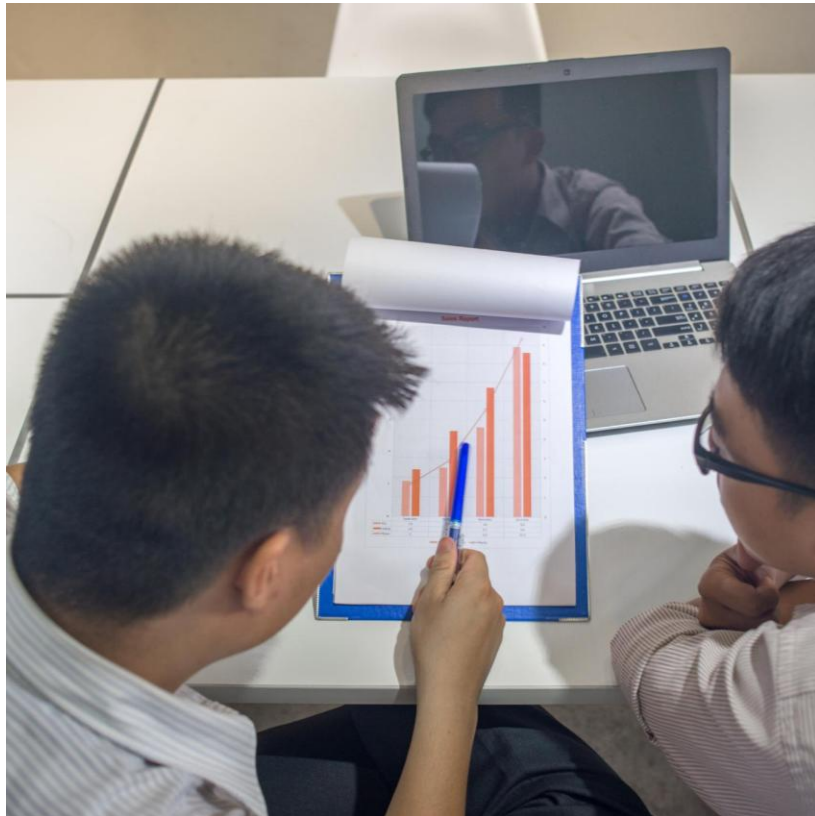
Reducing Absenteeism
