## Request to Expunge High School Courses Taken in Middle School

In accordance with Virginia state regulations, PWCS Regulation 661-2, Section VII, permits parents of students who take a high school credit-bearing course in middle school to request that the grade be omitted from the student's high school transcript and the student not earn high school credit for the course. The guidelines and procedures for expunging grades for high school courses taken in middle school are available by contacting your child's school. If your student wishes to expunge a grade for a course completed during seventh grade - submit the form no later than the Monday after the completion of summer school following the student's eighth grade year. If your student wishes to expunge a grade for a course completed during eighth grade - submit the form no later than the Monday after the completion of summer school following the student's ninth grade year. Requests may not be submitted prior to completion of the course. The information below must be completed, printed, and submitted to the appropriate principal. Once received, school staff will omit the grade for the designated course from the student's transcript.
